The sacrificial offerings mentioned in the first five chapters of Leviticus are discussed in great detail in this morning's reading. Take, for example, the *Olah*. This week it appears with extra details. So, too, with a number of other sacrifices, particularly the *Minchah*, *Chatat* and *Asham*. What's important to emphasize is that all the offerings given were not in place of personal repentance. The priest could not wave his hand and offer atonement for the wrong committed. That was the obligation of the one offering the sacrifice. The priest was never God's intermediary. All Jews, according to our tradition, have always had a direct spiritual link to God--that theological axiom continues to this day.
