Let the pageantry begin! With great detail, this week's Torah reading describes the procedures the *Kohanim* followed during the Yom Kippur service. One of the more unusual rites involved incense. As the Talmud describes, incense was used for atonement. A sacred mixture of herbs and fragrances, once collected, was sprinkled on the holy altar. Scientists in Israel have attempted to follow the formula described in the Torah with great success. In an article published by the "Jerusalem Report", the compound brought the scientists into what was described as an "out-of-body" experience.
