Take note of chapter eleven, verse one: "And the people were like murmurers, speaking evil in the ears of the Lord." The text does not substantiate their claim. It chooses its words carefully: "They were like murmurers." The Torah is not suggesting that legitimate concerns not be expressed. The operative word is legitimate. Most of our complaints tend to be petty and superficial. The People Israel witnessed first-hand, the miracles brought to them by God, and yet even they found it necessary to complain. Thousands of years later, under circumstances indescribably better, things haven't changed all that much.
