SHABBAT ROSH HODESH ELUL PARASHAT RE'EH

This week's Torah reading begins with a choice: "See, this day, I set before you blessing and curse." The distinguishing characteristic of human beings is our ability to choose. Judaism repeatedly emphasizes our humanity as one that can supersede instinct. Unlike angels, at our best, we have the God-given inner strength to overcome temptation and apathy. At our worst, we are no different than animals. Grammatically, the Hebrew begins with the singular, "See," later adding a plural suffix-"before you." As if to say, choice begins with oneself, but the implications of that choice impacts on the entire community. Savor the gift of choice, and as always, choose wisely.
