PARASHAT B'REISHIT

This week we begin the “re-reading” of the Torah, with *Parashat B'reishit*. The most important words in the portion, if not the entire Torah, appear in this morning's reading: *Ki Tov*—it was good. “And God saw that it was good!” As you read the Torah portion, don't read it as some pseudo-scientific account of the world's origin, as a simplistic alternative to Evolution. Read it as a polemic against nihilism. Read it as a plea—the world does not have to be exclusively chaotic or random. The world is “good”. True, it is up to us to make it better, but at its core, God's creation of the world is good!
