PARASHAT VAYELEKH

The Shabbat between Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur is treated as a special Shabbat - Shabbat Shuvah. Subsequently, the Haftarah has no thematic connection to the Torah portion. In the opening remarks of the Haftarah, Hosea (8th cent. B.C.) speaks of the social ills of his day by declaring: "Return, O Israel, to the Eternal your God." A younger contemporary of Amos, Hosea lived in the Northern Kingdom. While he targeted his remarks to the ones responsible for his country's social decline, he padded his harsh critique by saying, "God will forgive those who mend their ways." What was true then is true today: "God will forgive those who mend their ways."
