ELLIOT SCHWARTZ

Remembered by Beverly Schwartz

My husband, Elliot Schwartz, always considered himself to be the luckiest of men. Born in Los Angeles in 1935 to loving parents, he grew up in a very Jewish environment. He was the big brother to two siblings and had an enviable childhood, complete with an active group of friends in Hebrew school. After college, with a strong business and accounting major, he joined the National Guard and then came home to work with his dad in the family business. He met and married Beverly, and in their fifty-three years together, had three children and five grandchildren, all of them the loves of his life.

Elliot was a man of great integrity, a loving, wise and generous man.

Throughout his adult life, people would come to him for emotional and financial support and advice which he freely gave when asked. He was loved and respected by many and was a born leader, delighting in activities such as the Masons where he was Master of Menorah Lodge, and the synagogue where he



was an active member. He had many friends and derived much comfort from them in his later days. He was a talented artist and started painting in oils in his early fifties. Elliot loved holiday dinners and parties and schmoozing with friends and family. He had a full life and he is sorely missed.

ABRAHAM BIENSTOCK Remembered by Abraham Bienstock



My father, Abraham Bienstock, or Abe as everyone called him, was born in a hospital and raised on the Lower East Side of Manhattan. It's significant that he was actually born in a hospital since his older four siblings survived home births. Abe grew up very poor, as his father toiled in menial jobs, including working as a seltzer bottle filler. His father's life style was quite typical for an immigrant from Galicia - very pious and observant. It was because of his father's effort to transfer the same life-style to his son, that Abe later in life became a cultural Jew, attending synagogue only to celebrate Bar Mitzvahs and weddings. He was drafted into the Army as a young man and served in the Battle of the Bulge, where he was wounded in the arm by shrapnel. He was involved in liberation of a least one concentration camp, but never discussed the experience in much detail as it was so horrific to witness. During the war on leave in Toledo, Ohio, my father met my mother at a USO-sponsored Jewish community Thanksgiving dinner hosted by his future mother-in-law. He had a wonderful relationship with her and enjoyed conversing in Yiddish, much to the frustration of my mother whose understanding of Yiddish was minimal.

As a self-made man, my father was very proud of his success. When he first came to Los Angeles, he worked in the produce section of a grocery store. He enjoyed the experience and was called "frijole-

stock" by his Mexican co-workers. Wanting a better life, he went to night school at USC and became an accountant. He was very well liked by his clients, with whom he often socialized. Many paid him with goods, including jewelers who often gave him jewelry for my mother. He worked hard as an accountant, and usually celebrated the end of an exhausting tax season with a trip to Las Vegas. Always a very generous man, he eagerly picked up the check when he dined with friends and other members of the family. In fact, to this day, one of his nephews who inherited this trait calls the practice "doing an Uncle Abe."
