

BAYIT IN SESSION - JANUARY, 2024





























Makes: 8-10 servings

Prep Time: 10 minutes

INGREDIENTS:

1½ lbs. ripe firm fruit (e.g. peaches, plums, and/or strawberries)

8 oz. dark chocolate (around 70% is great), chopped into chunks

2 teaspoons coconut oil

Chili powder, to taste*

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Slice your fruit into ½" pieces if using peaches and plums. Strawberries can be left whole. Lay the fruit out on a clean kitchen towel or paper towels to dry them before using.
- 2. Add your chopped chocolate and coconut oil to a heatproof bowl. Either by placing your bowl over a pot of gently simmering water (make sure the bowl isn't touching the water), or in a microwave, heat the chocolate until it is just melted. Stir periodically.
- 3. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Once the chocolate is melted, dip each piece of fruit into it and then lay it flat onto the parchment paper. Sprinkle with chili powder if using. Once the baking sheet is full of fruit, immediately transfer it to the fridge to chill, for at least one hour or up to 6 hours before serving.
- * It's important to use a chili powder that is made of just chilis, avoid one with added garlic powder or other added spices
