### TICKETS WILL BE REQUIRED OF ALL PERSONS AGE 23+ AND WILL BE CHECKED AT THE DOOR.

Members of Kehillat Ma'arav will receive one ticket per adult once their membership renewal has been received.

We ask that all non-members of our community support our congregation and the increasing cost of yearly High Holiday services by contributing through ticket purchases as follows:

- Non-member: \$300 per adult age 23+
- Relative of a KM member: \$150 per adult age 23+
- College students, military, first responders (with ID): Complimentary
- Members receiving reciprocity from other synagogues: Complimentary

You many purchase additional tickets on our website or by calling our office at 310-829-0566. They can be sent via USPS, picked up at the KM office, or picked up at "will call" upon arrival at the check-in table.

At this time of year, we want to open our doors and encourage non-members to experience the benefits of affiliating with Kehillat Ma'arav. NO ONE WILL BE DENIED ADMISSION TO HIGH HOLIDAY SERVICES BECAUSE OF A GENUINE INABILITY TO PAY THE SUGGESTED CONTRIBUTION.

Tickets are for all five days of the holidays and are not provided on a service-by-service basis, and are non-transferable.

Members at other synagogues, regardless of affiliation, may request reciprocity in advance. They are given GUEST TICKETS and may attend at no cost. In turn, KM members in good standing may request reciprocity at other congregations across the country.

#### **PARKING**

The Skirball Cultural Center has plentiful, free parking in the North Garage. Once you've parked, you can use the elevators or the stairs to L2 and follow signage to Ahmanson Hall. We recommend planning your arrival 30 minutes before services begin to avoid congestion in the garage and ensure you an be checked in and seated in a timely fashion, with minimal disruption.
