# Remembered by her daughter, Susan Bronstein

My Mom was born in 1931 in Philadelphia, the youngest of four children born to Russian immigrants, Anna and Samuel Zubkin. She grew up living over the family's corner grocery store. After high school she worked as a secretary. In 1952 she met my Dad on a blind date. They married in 1954 and after Officer's Training, Dad immediately got papers to serve at Ellsworth AFB in South Dakota. Mom left her family to start a different life with her husband. She learned to drive and started their family with three children. Their next base was Amarillo, Texas where my youngest sister was born. After five years in Texas, we spent 18 months at Chanute AFB in Illinois, followed by four months back in Philly before Mom took all four children to Okinawa where Dad was stationed from 1965–

1968. Final move was to March AFB where they settled down in Riverside, CA. During all this time Mom was the perfect Air Force Officer's wife and best Mom. When Dad was away on his many military missions Mom took care of everything on the home front. She would home school us when we were sick or traveled. We'd come back to school always ahead of our classmates. My sisters and I always thought we were the best dressed among our friends. Mom always told us we could do anything. Keep a positive attitude, smile on your face and good humor, would get you far. Mom was active in the Officer's Wive's Club, Sisterhood, Temple and PTA. She attended PTA meetings and made sure we attended Religious School. She became a Girl Scout Troop Leader when we were in Okinawa and Youth Group Advisor at our Temple in Riverside. When Dad retired from the Air Force, Mom received a military commendation for all the hours she put in as a military wife so Dad could do his job. She was blessed with four grandsons and made a point to attend all their school and extracurricular events. Mom would ask me why I volunteered so much and I told her I was following in her footsteps. She was my role model and I miss all our time together.
